



家庭暫托中心 - 客人享受音樂治療的幫助

卑詩護理會的家庭暫托中心 (FRC) 提供專業護理予有精神或身體缺陷的長者，對於需要長期照顧他們的照顧者(caregiver) 提供可以有喘息的空間。家庭暫托中心能幫助照顧者在沉重的工作中，有喘息或擁有自己的休息時間，於日後就更有能力照顧親人/病人。

家庭暫托中心所提供的服務非常多，客人除可與其他客人或義工有社交聯誼活動外，當中還包括一些治療項目。好像中心的音樂治療師Danny Tsang每週二下午會出現暫托中心。透過音樂治療幫助客人。Danny會拿起結他，帶領小組演唱熟悉的歌曲。“我希望可以吸引所有人，甚至是一些似乎並不感興趣的客人” Danny說“有些客人可能是有溝通障礙，有些可能是因為老退化症或其他原因”他繼續說“但當你一旦與他們聯系上，就可以建立更多溝通的關係”

有些客人懂得一些旋律會跟著唱，另一些會拍掌或跟隨拍子移動。還有其他客人可能會分享他們的故事 - 在唱“Loch Lomond”時，有一位客人立刻回應說“我來自蘇格蘭”並希望與Danny一起帶領唱歌。在一個旋律中歌詞說“你感到寂寞嗎？”有另一位客人說“我從沒有孤獨過”但很快，他又補充說“除了在莫斯科戰爭期間，是一個黑暗時代之外，之後所發生過的都是快樂時光”

那時，另一位有語言障礙的客人仍然手舞足蹈地跳躍著，Danny走過去，她站在那邊迎接他並一起隨著音樂跳舞。“這時刻很美” Danny說“你可以說，這正是他們回味生命中最美好的時刻”

GUESTS ENJOY MUSIC THERAPY PROGRAMMING AT THE FRC

At our Family Respite Centre (FRC), seniors with cognitive decline or physical frailties receive temporary care from our dedicated nursing staff. Their caregivers get a break from the often exhausting responsibility of looking after a loved one. When caregivers are given the opportunity to take care of errands, or simply catch up on their own rest, they are able to care for their loved ones in their own homes for longer.

While at the FRC, guests benefit from socializing with other guests, staff and volunteers, as well as advanced recreational and therapeutic programs. Certified music therapist Danny Tsang visits the FRC Adult Day Program every Tuesday afternoon. Danny leads the group singing familiar songs while playing the guitar. "I try to engage everyone, even the people at the edge of the room who might not seem as interested," Danny says. "Some of the guests may have issues with communication – perhaps because of dementia or another condition," he continued, "but it's very special when you make a connection – when you engage with someone."

Many FRC guests will sing along when they know the words; others will clap and tap their toes to the beat. Other guests will share their own stories – before singing "Loch Lomond", one guest mentioned "I'm from Scotland!" and decided to sing with Danny to lead the group. Before leading the group in a version of

"Have You Ever Been Lonely?", another guest said "I've never been lonely". But after considering a moment, he added "except for during the war, outside Moscow". It was a memory of darker times, but also a reminder of all the happy times that had happened since then.

Another guest, who doesn't speak English, still enjoys dancing – as Danny makes his way around the room, she stands to greet him and dance along to the music. "These moments are beautiful", Danny says. "You can tell that their good memories are returning."

The FRC receives support and operational funding from Vancouver Coastal Health. However, additional programming like music therapy is made possible through financial donations to Care BC.
